

Stair Tower Course

This one day FASET course provided by 3 Education gives knowledge for those wishing to learn how to erect temporary stair towers in line with European Standards and manufacturers instructions; typically for the benefit of the industrial roofer and those needing to access the roof during construction or maintenance works.

Outcome

At the end of this course, Candidates will know how to correctly plan work with other trades under typical site conditions.

They will be able to build a Stair Tower in line with manufacturers instructions, industry good practice and the European standards.

They will know how to do this safely and handover the Tower.

The Candidates are provided with FASET Reference Notes, Manufacturers Instructions, Attendance Certificate (valid for 2 years) and Registration on FASET's Training matrix.

Competence

Those that pass the test and practical assessment on the day may apply for an endorsement on their current blue CSCS Net Rigging card or apply for a stand alone blue CSCS card (valid for 5 years).

Job Functions

Include; Safety Net Riggers, Roofers, Height Safety Contractors, Scaffolders, Steel Erectors and Frame Builders.
